

Dear Fellow Contesters,

Thank you very much for joining the Baltic Contest 2016, where we have had about 500 of you. That is pretty good but still not enough to solve the last hour activity question. The statistics say there were participants from more than 50 countries and the most numerous country was Germany with 51 participants. There were 146 callsigns from the Baltic States (86 from Lithuania, 30 from Latvia and 30 from Estonia).

From all the Baltic States, the Lithuanians have received the major trophies: LY5R Alberto was the first in the MIX entry, Albinas LY2MM has won the name of best CW man, Roli LY4A and Alius LY2BKT made the best team, and Kestas LYR-346 was the best listener. The SSB medal has gone to the multiple winner of this entry Karlis YL2CI and the 2 hours best scorer was Kristjan ES7GM.

The European entry Group A (MIX category) was lead by Yuri EW8DX; CW entrants, as usually, faced the biggest competition, where Jerzy SP4W was the first with only 20 pts ahead of OL4W. This year, in European SSB section, we welcomed Vlad UT7HA on the TOP. Romuald SP4G was the No 1 in the 2 hours competition. The main fight for the European Team winner in the Baltic Contest was among two Belorussian crews: EU1WW and EW8W. Congratulations to EU1WW! We shall not

forget the SWLs. Rafal SP7-003-24 took the 1st place for the second time in a row.

It has become a tradition without any participants in the Group A among the DX stations. However, the real competition was only in CW category and Sergey R8TT won. All the other entries were won by Sergey R9CZA in SSB, Fred K3ZO in the 2 hours entry, Tim N3QE in the multi operator's entry and Tom VK2CCC in the SWL category.

We would like to thank all the participants and congratulate all the winners. 

The Baltic Contest took place on the 22nd May, 2016. A team of 6 people gathered from korp! TauTiTo ¹ active members tried their luck in the amateur radio contest for the first time. Also, this contest was a grand opening of a new position establishment in Sangrūda, located in the South-West of Lithuania, near the Russian and Poland border. This position was built only days ago by sdr. Rolandas Žakelis from korp! TauTiTo.

The team consisted of 3 women and 3 men: Ina Žakelienė (callsign LY4O, now LY500), Neringa Vaičiūnaitė (LY3ZM), Karolina Vaičiūnaitė (LY3ST), Rolandas Žakelis (LY5AA), Dainius Bernatavičius (LY2ZO) and Rimas Šeperys (LY1GW). All were very excited, even though, the contest started late at night and it was hard to remain focused and attentive while on air. The contest was more like a practice as the team had to share one transceiver.

All in all, each member has been on air for at least one hour during the contest. Rolandas Žakelis was helping everyone and giving advices how to participate efficiently. From the female participants, the luckiest was Ina (now LY500): she made 68 QSOs. Second was Neringa LY3ZM. From the male: Rolandas Žakelis LY5AA with 36 QSOs.








The number of participants in the Baltic Contest by the different countries




QSO rates of MIX mode leaders

The 53rd BALTIC CONTEST 2017

General rules

The Lithuanian Radio Sports Federation has the honor to invite radio amateurs all over the world to enter 53rd Baltic Contest 2017.

- 1. Aim of the BC:** to promote radio sport in the Baltic countries and to expand relations among radio amateurs of the Baltic and the world.
- 2. The object of BC:** to establish as many contacts as possible with amateur stations worldwide.
- 3. Period:** from 2100z May 20, 2017 till 0200z May 21, 2017.
- 4. Sections:** A – single operator, CW/SSB

B – single operator, CW
C – single operator, SSB
D – single operator, 2 hours, CW/SSB
E – multi operator, single TX
F – SWL

- 4.1.** Any use of DX spotting networks (Skimmer, DX cluster, sked pages and etc.) for section A, B, C, D is not permitted.
- 4.2.** Only one transmitted signal is allowed at any time.
- 4.3.** Only one period of two hours with biggest QSO number counts for section D competition, all contacts made outside this period will be automatically used for check.
- 5. Frequencies:** CW (3510-3600) kHz, SSB (3600-3750) kHz.
- 6. Exchange:** RS(T) and serial number starting from 001. Each station may be worked once in SSB and once in CW.
- 7. Scoring:** for participants in Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania each QSO with Europe counts 1 point and QSO with another continent counts 2 points. For participants in Europe each QSO with Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania counts 10 points, each QSO with another participant counts 1 point. For participants outside Europe each QSO with ES, YL, LY counts 20 points, each QSO with another participant counts 1 point. SWL report must contain both call signs and at least one of the control numbers.
- 8. Final score:** the sum of QSO points. When the number of points is equal, the criteria for priority are: for better percentage of QSO confirmation; for more DX QSO
- 9. Awards:** certificates will be awarded to the leading stations of each section for every country (DXCC) in accordance with the number of participants. Winners in A, B, C, D, E, F sections in the Baltic countries (ES, LY, YL), in the Europe and outside Europe will receive originally designed medals.

The log MUST show the following information: call sign of participant, name, age, entry, power, and QSO in chronological order. Each contact has to have correct time in GMT, frequency (or band), call, report with serial number sent, and report with serial number received. A log without all required information may be reclassified to checklog.

11. Disqualification: If any participant violates contest rules, referees' committee can disqualify that participant.

Since 2012 was introduced CLUB COMPETITION STANDING class. Short rules are below.

Short rules of Lithuanian Cup

Aim of the contest: to clarify the best contestants, to promote radio sport and to increase skill of contestants in on-site competitions.

Participants:

1. On-site participants are single operators only (call signs LY17A - LY17Z). Transmitter power is limited to 10 W. Each participant is supervised by referee during whole contest time. Applications or requests of on-site competitor for more detail information (technical requirements, detail rules, accommodation, etc.) should be sent to organizers (see section Logs). Deadline of registration for on-site participants is 10th of June, 2017.

2. Other participants: **a)** single operator; **b)** team (multi op., single tx).

Time: 24rd of June 2017, 1500-1630 UTC in three periods: 1500-1529 UTC, 1530-1559 UTC, 1600-1630 UTC.

Frequencies: 3520-3600 kHz - CW, 3600-3700 kHz SSB.

Exchange: RS(T) + serial number of QSO. Each station may be worked once in CW and once in SSB during each period (max 6 QSO with the same call sign).Please to follow QSY rule (the same as in European Sprint).

Scoring: **1.** On-site competitors: 1 QSO = 1 point (no multipliers). **2.** QSO with LY17 prefix counts 2 points, QSO with other participant – 1 point.

Multiplier is a number of different LY17 calls during the all contest time.

Awards: winners (on-site, single op. and team) will receive trophies. Certificates will be awarded to the leading stations in every DXCC country. Special awards are for QSO with all on-site participants.

3. In Club Competition Standing, the on-site participant scores are multiplied with on-site competition participant numbers.
